- Updated Outreach Policy:
 - Completed - to be reviewed at the next Council meeting when I am in attendance. Existing Trustees and Jane Clare have been made aware.
- May 19 GLBT Mass of Inclusion:
 - Went very well. I think you all have a link to a blog written about it - let me know if you need it. Good Shepherd should be proud of taking a public and visible stance. Thanks to Fr. Mich and Ann Castiglione for getting our GASIC ministry off the ground 15 years ago.
- Council/Trustee Installation:
 - Please ALL come to one of the June 1/2 masses. Members leaving Council and leaving the Trustee position will be thanked. New Council members and the new Trustee will be welcomed. Incumbent members and new members and Trustee will be installed. All will be blessed.
- Worship Space upgrade:
 - Please trust the process. Over the past two years, we have carefully and deliberately involved all leadership (staff, Councils, Prayer & Worship) in discernment regarding possible upgrade items (19 total) and ranked them. We received a “future vision” rendering from Conrad Schmidt. We have received another rendering specific to the wall. **The only decision made to date** is to move the music group to the Northeast section and reconfigure seating. The physical move is Phase 1 of the music group move. Phase 2 is to flesh out the move with things like risers, flooring behind the altar and in the new music group section, adjustment of lighting and sound. We will rely heavily on S. Joann and Tim Ehlinger to give direction on these Phase 2 items. Though all are excited about the wall and all support it, no decision has been made yet about the wall, or any other items, pending cost and discerned approval.
