I ask you to help accelerate progress on global nutrition by supporting an increase in funding to \$250 million in the fiscal year 2020 appropriations bill.

Almost half of all child deaths worldwide are linked to malnutrition. The children who survive remain at high risk of irreversible stunting, which affects their physical growth and brain development.

We are making progress, but it is far too slow. Providing \$250 million for global nutrition this year could reach more than 10 million women and 7 million children. There is a bipartisan House Resolution 189 that needs your support.

My faith calls me to have compassion and stand alongside women and children around the world. Decreasing poverty creates a more stable world for everyone.
